SUMMARY of Region Activities

March 3, 2011

An Information (IT) Innovation Summit titled “California Teachers Lead the Way” was held in Sacramento, CA . The goal of the summit was to promote partnerships, innovative strategies and student engagement that lead to information technology core education and skills in the classroom that will ensure success in a global economy. The summit took place in conjunction with the 2011 Educating for Careers Conference.

April 15, 2011

The Bay Area Community College Consortium convened the Community Colleges and Workforce Investment Boards in the region to consider shared interests in Health Information Technology (Health IT). Seven areas for potential collaboration were identified, highest among them were learning more about Health IT labor market needs. This study, led by the Health Workforce Initiative (California Community College Chancellor's Office Economic and Workforce Development Program) and at least partially funded by the WIB-CC project, is a result of that interest and sheds light on where within the healthcare sector Health IT skills are most in demand and what those skills are.

April 29, 2011

An Energy Faculty Forum – an outcome of the New Energy Workforce Initiative and co-planned by the BACCC, Foothill and the Foothill-De-Anza CACT - was held at Diablo Valley College.

June 13-17, 2011

MPICT will be hosting Faculty Development Week in San Francisco. This is the second year that MPICT is holding this event and more than 70 faculty are expected to attend. The agenda will include:

Refine Bay Region CTE Data

The BACCC is involved in a CTE Employment Outcomes Project. An effort is being led by Rock Pfothauer and Kitty O’Doherty to replicate the Cabrillo annual CTE completer/leaver survey in partnership with several interested collaborators/colleges across the state, including the RP Group. The purpose of this effort is to address the lack of CTE outcomes data across our

system. The intent is to build on Cabrillo's and other college's success in surveying their CTE completer/leavers; and to reduce costs and gain economies of scale by doing it statewide.

Embark on a Regional Sector Strategy

A proposal was submitted to the Bay Area Workforce Funding Collaborative to partially fund the Regional Sector Strategy. The BACCC region has chosen to align behind healthcare in partnership with the Centers of Excellence and Health Workforce Initiative while simultaneously working with John Carrese, (Centers of Excellence) on preparing data for regional review and selection of an additional sector to align regionally behind.
