Old business and announcements:

Responses to regional input on issues initiated at Fall 2005 General Business meeting:

- Board structure (the issue was raised that the three-year commitment to serve as President-elect/conference chair, President, Past-President might be too long to attract many members to leadership roles) was determined by membership/regional input to remain the same.
- Regarding the encouragement of membership/regions for the CCCAOE board and organizational role reflected in the work plan should include a legislative advocacy role and legislative issues to be addressed. Board will meet with CCLC legislative liaison Nick Kremer (Community College League of California) and determine strategies.

Topics for regional meetings:

- What is membership willing to do with regard to legislative advocacy and developing a presence in the political process in Sacramento and voting districts.
- As to the number of annual conferences to hold, the input received was to maintain the current structure of two per year, but with possibly a structure or format different for one such as link with other organizations (CIOs, CSSOs, or EWD, etc.) or focus on Sacramento elected officials visits.
- Fall 2006 conference will be held in Anaheim/Disneyland area at the Crowne Plaza Hotel. Provide suggestions for theme to Regional Vice Presidents.
- Suggestions for additional strands or conference format for Call for Presentations will be available on the CCCAOE web site. Current strands include Teaching & Learning, Accountability & Accreditation, Economic & Workforce Development, Leadership & Collaboration. Should there be specific topics sought under current strands? Possibilities include leadership development/mentoring, distance education.
