October 16, 2003

The business meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by President Kim Holland.

The minutes from the Spring CCCAOE Business meeting were approved.

Wayne Olson presented the Treasurer's report. After briefly reviewing the current balances, the Treasurer's report was approved.

Kim reviewed a list of CCCAOE Accomplishments since the Spring 2003 Conference in the interest of sharing with the membership the activities and efforts of the Board. As Kim indicated, all of the activities are in accordance with the CCCAOE mission statement.

Kim reported that at the June 2003 Board meeting, it was decided that the CCCAOE priorities for the 2003-2004 year were the following:

- Cultivating New Leadership on campuses and within CCCAOE.

- Monitoring Legislation, which includes communicating with state and federal legislators about the importance of vocational education and its vital role in the economy.

The Spring 2004 conference will be a joint CCCAOE/CIO conference in San Francisco, March 3-5, 2004. Kim encouraged members to consider submitting presentation proposals and registering early for the conference.

Anyone wishing to add an item to the General Business meeting to be reconvened on Friday, October 17, was asked to indicate in writing at the registration desk.

The Business Meeting was closed at 8:40 a.m.
